Give all scholars in Germany the means and opportunity to publish the results of their research in the journals of their choice with a Creative Commons open license that enables free use and re-use



Open Access Publishing



Authors affiliated with participating institutions can publish open access

- In ~1,800 journals in Elsevier's Core Hybrid portfolio
- In hybrid journals of Cell Press and The Lancet
- In around 700 Elsevier Fully Gold Open Access journals with a 20% discount on list APCs (15% discount for Cell Press and The Lancet journals).

Ensure that all German institutions have equal and permanent access to complete portfolios of scholarly journal content.



Access to content still behind the paywall



Participating institutions receive access to virtually the entire Elsevier portfolio

- Including Cell Press and The Lancet titles
- Including perpetual access to content published during their years of participation

Establish a fair, reasonable and future-oriented cost model



Costs articulated based on publishing



 Costs for OA publishing services and reading access are rolled up in "Publish and Read (PAR)" fees post-paid to Elsevier in direct relation to the number of articles published

Journals	#articles from Germany in 2022	Fee	Annual price increase
Core Hybrid Journals	~ 9,700	2,550€	+3%
Cell Press & The Lancet Journals	~ 400	6,450€	+4%
